Option for Oversight of Design and Construction Outline

- I. DWR will be responsible for design and construction of Conservation Measure No. 1 conveyance facilities
 - A. DWR Director will be responsible for all decisions
 - B. Contracts issued and administered pursuant to DWR procedures
 - 1. Contracts will processed by staff working under direction of Program Director
 - 2. Program Director's contract will be administered by staff that reports directly to DWR Director
- II. Public Water Agencies will form a joint powers authority to fulfill advice and consent role for design and construction
 - A. Agreement between DWR and JPA will prescribe role, responsibilities, and authorities of IPA
 - B. Any decision that will affect budget, schedule, capacity, or delivery capability of the conveyance facilities requires concurrence of JPA
- III. A Program Director will be retained to manage design and construction
 - A. Program Director will be selected by DWR Director with the concurrence of JPA
 - B. Program Director will report to DWR Director through JPA Board of Directors
 - C. Responsibilities and authorities of Program Director will be prescribed by three-party agreement among DWR, JPA, and Program Director
- IV. Design and construction will be performed by DWR staff, Public Water Agencies staff, and consultants
 - A. Program Director will have authority to make all staffing decisions related to design and construction
 - B. A Technical Committee consisting of DWR and Public Water Agencies staff will be created to advise the Program Director on day-to-day engineering questions and the resolution of issues that arise
 - C. DWR will assign to the Technical Committee a career executive appointee to manage DWR staff
